Welcome and introduction.

Principal Update from Robin-Reviewed new hire positions, still looking for ½ time math 5th grade teacher, 5th grade literacy and 2nd grade teacher. Discussed the 6th grade math option at Hill for 5th graders. 2018/19 Steck was charged \$7800 for this program. 2017/18 the 6th grade math option at Hill was available, with no cost to Steck. Unclear if this program will continue and if there is a necessity for it to continue.

Traffic Update: Traffic Volunteers for April/May. Discussed and decided that we would try to go by last name A-M, all grade levels April and N-Z all grade levels for May.
