Science Fair Rules

- Steck Scientists can choose to work independently, with a partner or on a team(max. 3 students). **Participation is optional!**
- **Team Projects:** Maximum of three members; teams compete in separate category; team members may not change from fair to fair; one member should be appointed team spokesperson; all team members' names must appear on Abstract Form.
- Adults can help gather materials and supervise your experiment, but remember this is YOUR science fair experiment. The ideas and work need to be YOURS!
- If you choose to participate, experiments are required for Intermediate [3-5] Students and will be judged. You will be judged on the use of the Scientific Method. Primary Students [K-2] may choose collections and models but will not be judged. DPS's District Science Fair does not allow any Report/Collection or Model Style Projects.
- **Team Projects by 2 or 3 students are judged in a separate category than independent projects at the DPS Science Fair.**
- Science Fair winners are eligible for entry in the DPS Science Fair. (Date: TBA)
