Dear Steck Community,

As the school year comes to a close, we would like to thank everyone again for making it such a success for kids! Parents, teachers and para-educators should celebrate the wonderful growth and accomplishments that kids have demonstrated all year!

Early in the school year, we set academic goals for literacy and math in K-5. We ended the school year with 81% of K-5 Steck students as measured by i-Ready as reading were "at or above grade level". 86% of K-5 Steck students were measured by i-Ready as "at or above grade level" in math.

This is a high bar that we hope to reach and surpass next year. Teachers will spend time in professional learning this summer and their first week back in August. Many are focusing on “whole child” issues and how to best support students socially and emotionally. We will continue with the *Empowering Education*, program next year as well as other processes to give students more choice and ownership of their learning.

We are looking forward to welcoming our new staff members who have already begun work with us; Kat Wallach (grade 2 Literacy), Samantha Daniel (Learning Specialist, aka., Special Education), Lindsay Rooney, (Special Education Para-Educator), Kelly Nykamp (Speech/Language Pathologist) and are reluctantly saying good-bye to those who are leaving; Bev Herbert, Joyce Rosenblum, April Crabill, Courtney Rossman and Anne Kalick.

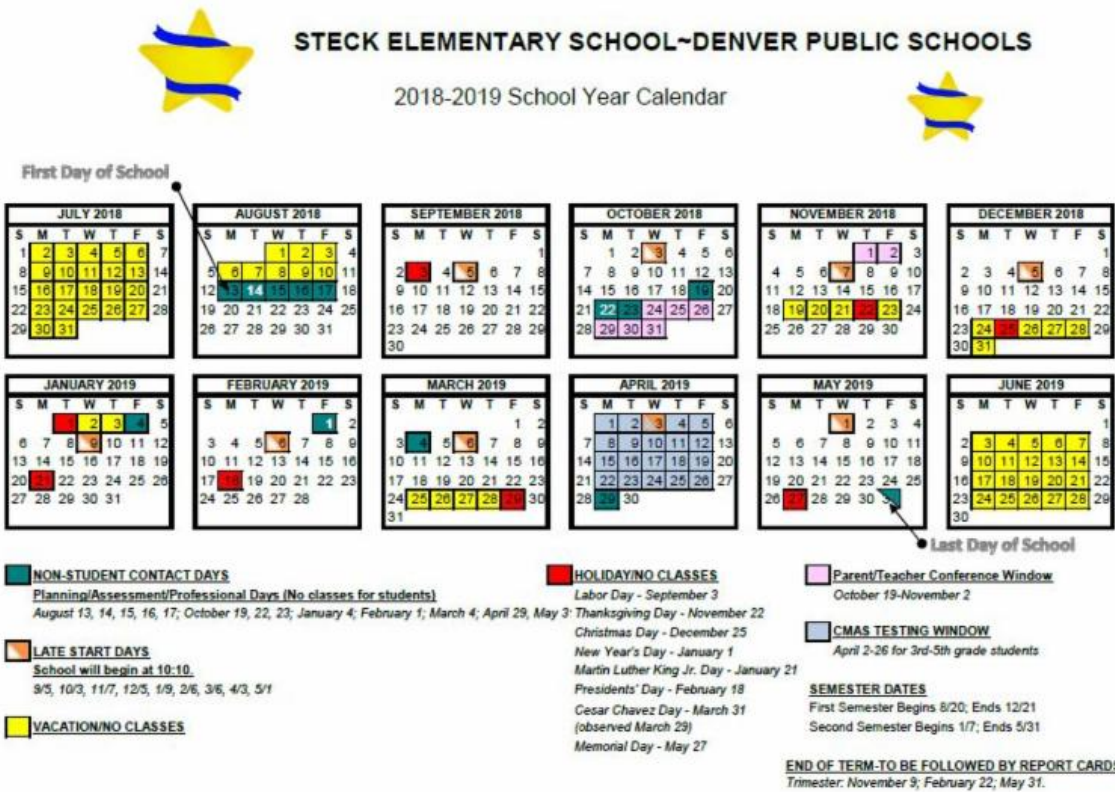
Also, we will be changing the way we do drop off and pick up
