School Crossing Guards help school children cross the street safely. School Crossing Guards are required to be dependable and able to work outside during adverse weather. This position offers Ten (10) hours per week, \$12.00 per hour.

Crossing Guards will be asked to work mornings and afternoons (hours will depend on assigned school start and dismissal times): \$240.00 (before taxes) every 2 weeks.
